
## Configuring IMAP in Outlook 2010

I) Go to Start > Control Panel and launch the Mail applet




- 2) Click on Show Profiles button
- 3) Click the Add button
- 4) A New Profile window will pop up

In the **Profile Name** field enter the name of the user and click **OK**.




## 5) In the Add New Account window select

Manually configure server settings or additional server types, and then click **Next**.



## 6) Then select

Internet Email (Connect to POP or IMAP server to send and receive email messages).



## 7) Fill out the following information:

#### **Server Information**

Account Type: <select IMAP>

Password: <your mailbox password>




## 8) Click on More Settings


### 9) Click on the Advanced tab

Use port **993** for *Incoming server* (*IMAP*) and select **SSL** in the dropdown for *Use the following type of encrypted connection* (*SSL*), then click **OK**.






10) Click on Test Account Settings.
